- 1. PLEASE USE DISPOSABLE CONTAINERS THAT DON'T NEED TO BE RETURNED OR.MARK ALL DISHES AND UTENSILS WITH YOUR NAME.**
- 2. PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR DISHES ARE TAKEN HOME AT THE END OF EACH MEAL.**
- 3. If you bring a salad, bring it already mixed in a bowl. Send a bottle of dressing with the salad (on the side). Italian, Caesar and Ranch dressings are most favored.**
- 4. If you're bringing bread/rolls, please bring butter. (Tub or cubes)**
- 5. Hot dishes should be brought pre-heated and/or in crock pots that can be plugged in to keep warm. We have NO heating facilities available to us.**
- 6. If you're bringing water bottles, please buy 16oz. ones, and bring 36 of them.**
- 7. If you'd like to donate paper towels or wet wipes that can be used each week to clean down the tables, that would be great.**
